DAUGHTER OF SSGT JAMES W. SALUS, USAF

*Marie N. Salus was the daughter of Chief Master Sergeant James W. Salus, USAF. Salus was stationed at the Clark Air Base in the mid 1960s when he was a young Staff Sergeant. His daughter Marie passed away on January 11, 1964 while assigned to Clark and was interred at the Post Cemetery. Salus went on to serve in many other billets and assignments retiring to his home in Virginia.*

*Jim Salus was a member of American Legion Post 177 in Fairfax, Virginia. He passed away August 13, 2009. The members of Post 177 established an annual golf tournament in his memory and send the proceeds from this tournament to VFW Post 2485 in Angeles City, Philippines to help defray the cost of maintaining the Clark Veterans Cemetery. In 2010, Post 177 sent \$1,758.00.*

*Jim, his family, friends and comrades were gratified and relieved to learn that his daughter's grave site and the Clark cemetery were still being cared for long after the USAF departed in 1991 through the voluntary efforts of VFW Post 2485 in Angeles City, Philippines. As a way to say thank you to their comrades in VFW Post 2485, American Legion Post 177 established the James Salus Memorial Golf Tournament in Jim's name. Proceeds help defray the cost of administering and maintaining the cemetery pending transfer back to the US Government.*
